### **RICHMOND REGION COVID-19 SAFETY STANDARDS**

The state of Virginia is currently in [phase 3](#) of the “Forward Virginia” plan to continue safely and gradually easing public health restrictions while continuing measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Chesterfield County Parks and Recreation has put a plan in place to implement the state’s guidelines and has taken steps that will be visible at River City Sportsplex.

- **RIVER CITY SPORTSPLEX SAFETY PROTOCOLS:**
  - o **Signage:** Additional signage will be placed throughout the facility providing public health reminders and capacity limits. Signage will also be placed at the entrance of the facility stating no one with a fever or symptoms of COVID-19 or known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the past 14 days, is permitted to enter.
  - o **Cleaning High Touch Points:** Facility staff will work to regularly clean and disinfect shared surfaces, restrooms, and high-touch areas throughout the day.
  - o **Social Distancing:** Common seating areas (bleachers and picnic tables) will be removed or roped off as social distancing is being encouraged among tournament participants and spectators.
  - o **Hand Sanitizing and Hand Washing Stations:** Both will be made available throughout the facility.
